

Homeschool Physical Education Waiver Terms & Conditions

A release executed by the herein undersigned to Minot State University, its officers, agents, and employees.

In consideration of permitting my child to participate in Minot State University's Homeschool Physical Education program, I the undersigned, in full recognition and appreciation of the dangers and hazards inherent within, do hereby agree to assume the risks and responsibilities surrounding my child's participation therein and further, do for myself, my heirs, and personal representatives, hereby hold harmless, release and forever discharge Minot State University and all of its officers, agents, and employees from and against any liability, claims, demands, actions, or cause of action, on account of damage to personal property or personal injury or death which may result from my child's participation therein.

Any injury resulting from the Homeschool Physical Education program will be the financial responsibility of the participant's personal insurance.

I authorize any first aid or medical treatment deemed necessary in case of emergency. I understand that I will be responsible for any expense incurred on my child's behalf in connection with such treatment.

If my child has medication that may be needed during the Homeschool Physical Education program, I or a designated representative, will remain at Minot State University campus to administer the medication. I acknowledge that the leaders and director of the program are not able to provide or administer medication to minors.

As a condition of enrollment, this disclaimer of liability must be signed and dated by the participant's parent/legal guardian. My child participates in this program at their own risk. I certify that to the best of my knowledge my child is in good physical condition and has no disease or injury that would impair their performance in the program activities. If they fail to obey program rules, the teachers and director have the authority to ask them to leave the program.
